Silver member, **Gensler** San Jose, headed by Kevin Shaeffer, took on the challenging technical architectural renovation issues for Child and Family Services.

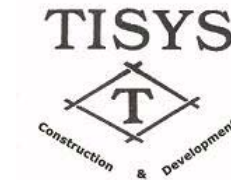
